- Recent graduates may participate within one year of graduation, if approved before completing studies.
- You must have completed at least the first year of studies.

Duration – Funding

- Traineeship minimum duration: 2 months (+2 travel days) – Funding for 4 months, with the possibility of two months extension
- Studies duration: one semester
- Short-term mobility: 5–30 days physical + virtual component
- Funding: 450–550€/month for studies, 600–700€/month for traineeships
- Extra 250€/month for students with fewer opportunities; full coverage for students with disabilities.
